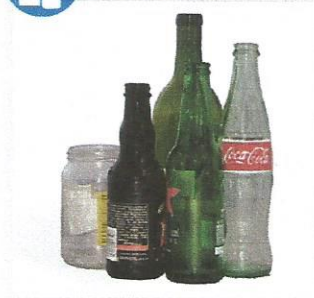
Aluminum, Steel, and Tin Cans

Return plastic bags to retailer.

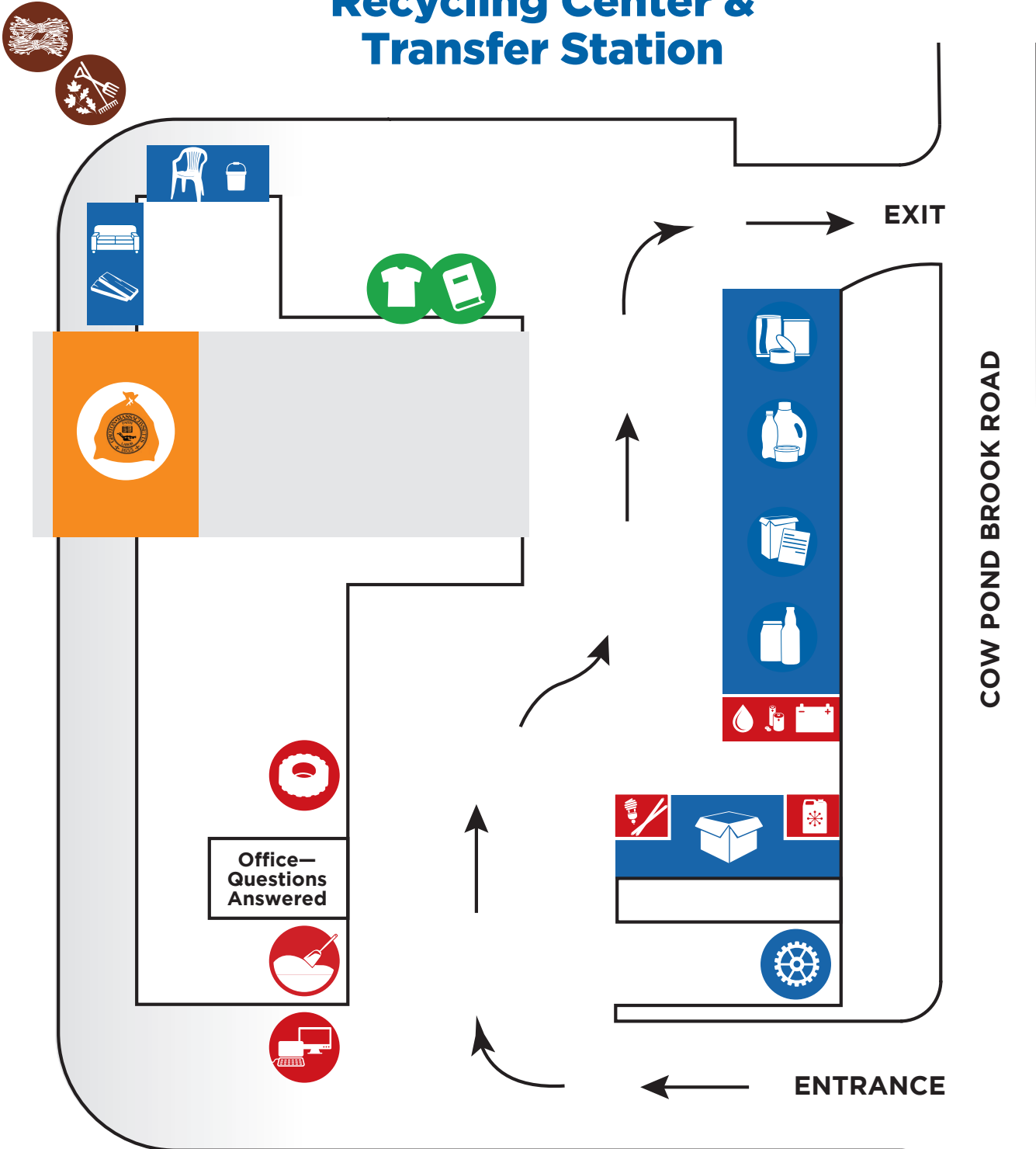
